

# KAYAK OUTING

- appropriate shoes (watersocks, booties, Tevas, old tennis shoes)
- waterproof windbreaker (jacket)
- hat with visor / sunscreen
- sunglasses with retainer
- water & snack, sack lunch
- extra set of clothes (just in case)
- camera / binoculars (bring at own risk)
- DAY PACK or plastic bag for gear

Dress in layers. Polypropylene, capilene, wool, silk, fleece, and synthetic clothing wick moisture away from skin and let you stay warmer. Avoid wearing cotton and jeans (if you can), as these can be cold and unsafe if wet!

## **DROP OFF & PICK UP:**

Do not drop off your scout and leave unless 2 adults or 1 adult & 2 youth are present.

**Re: picking up your scout** – Please be available / reachable 30 min. before and after the estimated return time. You will be called if trip is ending earlier or taking longer, and you are expected to be at the meeting place at the newly adjusted time. Any youth not picked up within 10 min. of arrival time may be sent home with a leader or other trip attendee who has at least 1 child present. BSA Youth Protection rules require that no adult at any BSA function may be alone with less than 2 youth.

An adult who must assume responsibility for your child may charge you for daycare or companion care at the rate of \$10/half hour. To avoid this, you should arrange for drop off at a neighbor or relative's home, if feasible, or for your child to go home with another scout – just let the leader know your alternate plan.
